<b>Why you get this notice</b>	Federal law requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. We will provide you with a Consumer Privacy Statement at the time you establish your relationship with us and on an annual basis thereafter.
<b>Types of personal information we collect</b>	The types of personal information we collect depend on the product or service you have with us. This information may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Social Security number, name, address, date of birth, driver's license, assets and income</li> <li>■ Account balances, payment history and parties to transactions</li> <li>■ Credit history, credit scores and payment history</li> </ul>
<b>Information we disclose</b>	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. The Bank of Mauston <b>DOES NOT DISCLOSE</b> any non public personal information about our customers and former customers to affiliates ( <i>companies related by common ownership</i> ) or non affiliated third parties ( <i>companies not related by common ownership</i> ), except as permitted by law.

<b>For our everyday business purposes</b>	To process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus
<b>For marketing purposes</b>	To offer our products and services to you
